- Deputy Honorary Secretary: In this role, you would support our current
 Honorary Secretary in arranging and recording committee meetings, ensuring
 governance procedures are followed and responding to regional
 correspondence.

As a committee member, you will be able to attend our meetings every 2 months to discuss the programme, and the flexibility to take part in a number of programmes of activities on an ad hoc basis. These activities include:

- Hosting Continuous Professional Development (CPD) events
