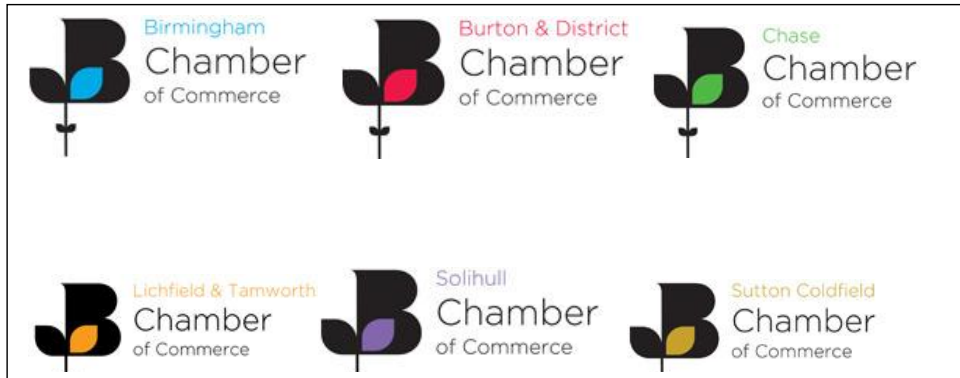


# The Greater Birmingham Chambers of Commerce
