Individual projects (less than £5 million) that are outstanding examples of transportation or highway projects, demonstrating they have been delivered on time, to budget and made a major contribution to the West Midlands. In addition, this year the judge's welcome examples that demonstrate effective management during the Covid19 pandemic on the health safety and wellbeing of workforce and customers.

Entries must clearly explain how the submission meets the criteria specified.

Maximum marks attainable for each criteria noted in brackets.

Judging Criteria for the award:

- Benefits to the community (15)
- Benefits to the environment (15)
- Implementation and delivery of project (15)
- Engagement and communication with Stakeholders (10)
- Planning and Design (10)
- Enterprise, innovation and ingenuity (10)
- Objectives met including time, cost & quality (10)
- Value for money with benefits versus costs (10)
- Wider implementation potential (5)
