

TPP Professional Standards Committee: February 2018

The TPP qualification is managed jointly by CIHT and TPS through the TPP Professional Standards Committee (PSC). This committee meets four times a year. The following is a summary of the February 2018 meeting.

At the February 2018 meeting, the PSC received a draft report from Professor Lyons on the five stakeholder workshops that had been held in January and early February to review the TPP knowledge requirements. The committee agreed that the report should be circulated for comment to those who had participated in the workshops. Once the report was finalised, further discussions would be held on next steps.

Updates were presented on Masters course approval, TPP Chartered status, and the TPS Professional Development Scheme.

The Chair, Dougie MacDonald, thanked Nick Richardson for his invaluable contribution to the committee as this was his last meeting. Nick previously chaired the PSC and has actively supported and promoted the TPP qualification since its launch in 2008.
