



TPP Professional Standards Committee: May 2017 Update

The TPP qualification is managed jointly by CIHT and TPS through the TPP Professional Standards Committee (PSC). This committee meets four times a year. The following is a summary of the latest meeting in May.

At the May meeting, the PSC confirmed the results of the 17 recent TPP Professional Review applicants, 11 of which were successful. The PSC was pleased to note that this was the highest number of applicants in a single session, reflecting the increasing popularity and importance of the qualification. Interviews were held in London, Cardiff and Glasgow with candidates from across the UK and from a range of employers in both the public and private sector. The committee also confirmed one new Senior Route success.

The PSC audits Professional Review interviews. Following feedback from reviewers and auditors there will be some changes made to the way interviews are conducted. In future, candidates will be asked to give a 10 minute presentation (rather than 20 minutes) including a general introduction and project specific competency based element. Candidates will be asked to state which of the competencies they plan to evidence during the presentation.

Finally, on behalf of the committee, Chair Dougie McDonald thanked Bill Wyley for his 'excellent and dedicated service' to PSC and to the TPP qualification. Bill will be stepping down from the PSC to be replaced by Keith Buchan. Bill has been involved in the development and management of the TPP since its inception and has provided exemplary support throughout his time on the PSC.
