

TPP Professional Standards Committee: May 2018

The TPP qualification is managed jointly by CIHT and TPS through the TPP Professional Standards Committee (PSC). This committee meets four times a year. The following is a summary of the February 2018 meeting.

At the May 2018 meeting, the PSC considered the reviewer recommendations from the professional reviews held earlier in the month as well as one Senior Route application. Two interviews had been audited and no procedural non-compliances were identified. The committee agreed to review the appeals procedure at the next meeting.

Professor Lyons gave an update on the knowledge requirements review report (*The 10-year TPP Review*). The committee agreed that revisions to the TPP units were required and that a proposal should be put to the TPP Partnership Management Group* for undertaking this work. This also fitted in with the committee's plans to prepare the qualification for an international market.

Updates were presented on TPP Chartered status, the TPS Professional Development Scheme and CIHT's CPD review.

The Chair, Dougie McDonald, thanked Dawn Wylie for her contribution to the work of the PSC and in particular her work on Masters course approval.

As this was Dougie McDonald's last meeting as Chair, the committee thanked him for his leadership over the past two years. Steve Hunter will take over as Chair for two years from the next meeting.

The next PSC meeting is on 20 September 2018.
