A brief history lesson

- April 2008 – March 2009
 - Extensive promotion at exhibitions and events
 - Continued ‘tweaking’ of system
 - Discussions with Road Safety GB
 - 100th member Sept 08 / 150th March 09
- March 2009 – September 2009
 - Work with Road Safety GB towards handover
 - Project Manager 1:1 sessions
 - 175th member in June 2009

 - Making sure RSTB is fully functional and supported
 - Provide additional assistance to Road Safety GB
