



TRANSPORT PLANNING TECHNICIAN APPRENTICESHIP END POINT ASSESSMENT (EPA) PROJECT PROPOSAL

Instructions

As part of your formal application to The Chartered Institution of Highways & Transportation (CIHT), the Professional Engineering Institution for the End Point Assessment you will submit an outline proposal of **one** project, chosen from the project briefs issued by CIHT, for approval.

Your project proposal should be typed and no more than 500 words in length, and should demonstrate your ability to bring together the high level knowledge, skills and behaviours that you have acquired during your apprenticeship to solve a transport planning problem.

Please provide your details below and submit this form by email to education@ciht.org.uk with your project proposal, and letters of support from your employer and learning provider to confirm that you are eligible to enter the EPA gateway.

You will receive feedback from CIHT within two weeks of submission regarding the suitability of your project proposal. You are advised to wait for this feedback before starting to compile your project presentation pack.

You will have **up to 3 months** to complete your project presentation pack, which must be submitted with your EPA application form. The presentation pack should contain the Outputs and Deliverables specified in your chosen project brief and should set out how you went about the project, any obstacles you needed to overcome, and the knowledge, skills and behaviours you needed to apply to complete it.
