CIHT South West Regional Awards 2019

Nominations are now open for the 2019 CIHT South West Awards. Prizes are up for grabs across four categories which are described below. Submissions should be emailed to southwest@ciht.org.uk before 5pm on Thursday 7th February 2019.

Nominations are strictly limited to 250 words. An independent panel made up of regional committee members will decide a shortlist for each category and the ultimate winners.

The awards will be presented during the CIHT South West Annual Black Tie Dinner and Awards Ceremony on Thursday 28th February 2019 at The Great Hall at the University of Exeter. Transportation Project of the Year

Recognising the best projects in the South West region which were completed, substantially completed or reached a significant milestone in 2018. Projects should illustrate best practice across a range of criteria. The project delivery team should be seen as ambassadors of their professionalism who will have demonstrated excellence in the planning or engineering field within the highways and transportation industry.

Transportation Innovation Award

Recognising the need to promote and encourage imaginative concepts and excellence in the transport industry. Entries can be based on innovative solutions to particular challenges within a project or a scheme that is innovative in its overall concept. The project must be based in the South West and have been completed, reached a substantial completion, or have reached a significant milestone in 2018.

Transportation Environment Award

Recognising that transportation professionals have a key role to play in protecting the environment and providing enhanced benefits for transport users and other stakeholders. Projects in the South West should demonstrate that they have had a measurable and meaningful positive impact on the environment with the benefits realised in 2018.

The Peter Swain Award for Emerging Professional of the Year

Recognising emerging professionals, aged 35 or under and based in the South West branch, who have made a significant contribution to the profession, through the development or sharing of knowledge, through their role on a project, and/or through the promotion of the profession. Shortlisted nominees will be awarded an invite to the top table at the Black Tie Dinner.
