Transforming Industry Productivity

The UK 2017 Industrial Strategy identified increasing construction sector productivity as critical for UK Plc Growth

Construction productivity has remained flat since early 1990s while manufacturing has transformed its output through new technology and methods

Highway England has being working with ICE, CIHT & industry partners to transform productivity through three key strategic innovations:

1. Regional Delivery Partnership

Re-defining the traditional role of Tier 1 Contractor to be a **Business Integrator** rather than **Risk Manager**

- Vertical Integration regional and national Centre of Excellence to deliver annual productivity & innovations plan
- ☐ Horizontal Integration integration of consultants and wider supply chain to focus on value outcomes not cost
- **Skills Integration** focus on workforce planning to drive apprentices, diverse recruitment & effective training plans

Creating a Digital Environment

- Next development of BIM & CAD
- Implementing AI computer modelling to design 80% of scheme components
- Enable Design Consultants to move from a labour based business model to a digital based solutions
- HE developed pilot "Rapid Engineering Model"
- Creates standardised, repeatable automated designs
