High quality operator; committed to becoming safer, greener and more efficient – this is the intermediate level of accreditation



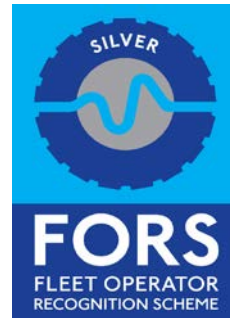
Gold

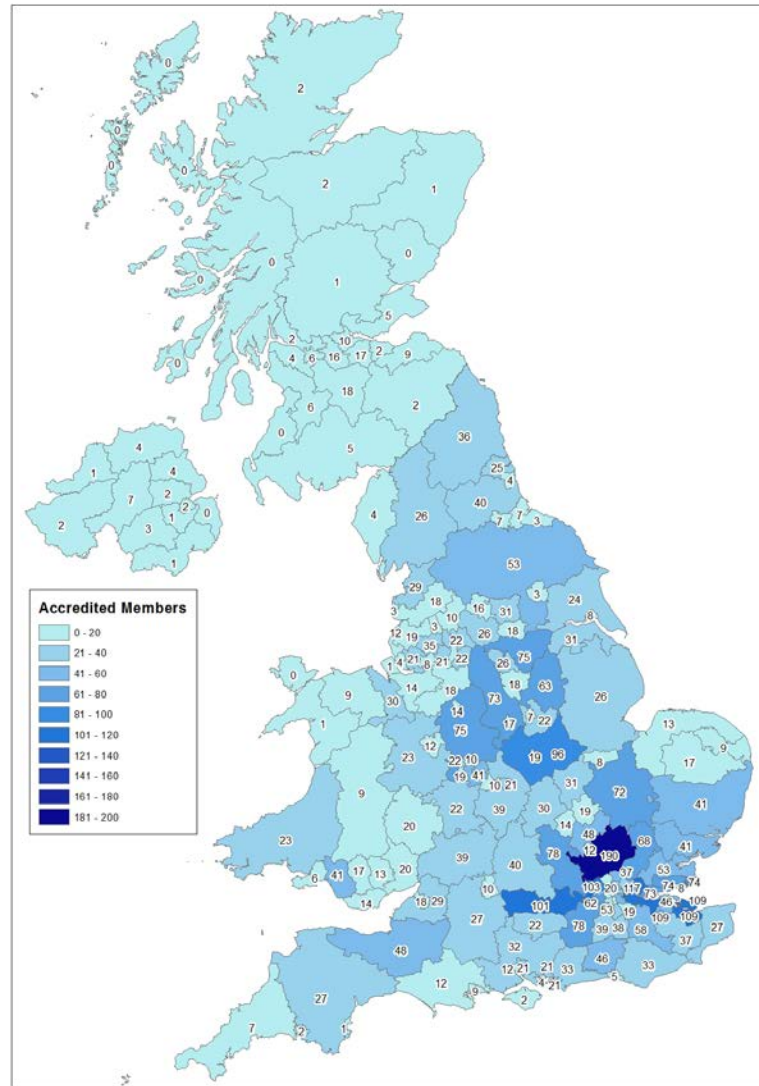

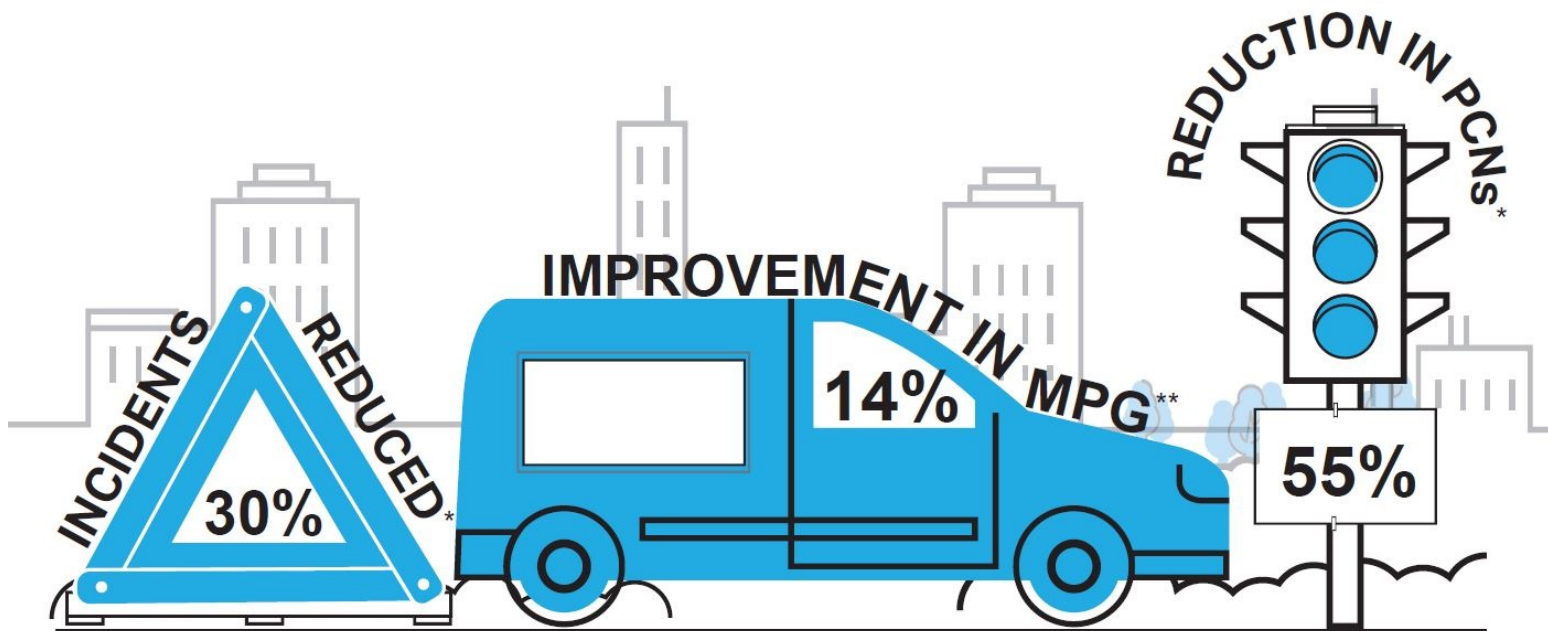

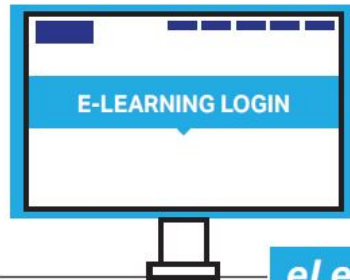
