Accessible & Inclusive Design Award 2026

This award recognises how outstanding design and implementation of schemes in towns, cities and rural areas improve the places around them for people and the environment.

When scoring, judges will be looking at how the entry demonstrates accessible and inclusive design, equitable delivery, removal of barriers, stakeholder engagement or other relevant areas. Therefore, it is important to highlight any of these components in your entry.

This award recognises those schemes or projects that have created new places or improved existing ones and have demonstrated how the changes have met some of the following objectives:

- Created an inclusive environment
- Creating ease of movement for all users
- Improved the accessibility of a transport system
- Improved the safety and health of the public
- Improved the quality of the place where the scheme is situated
- Has provided both environmental, social and economic benefits
