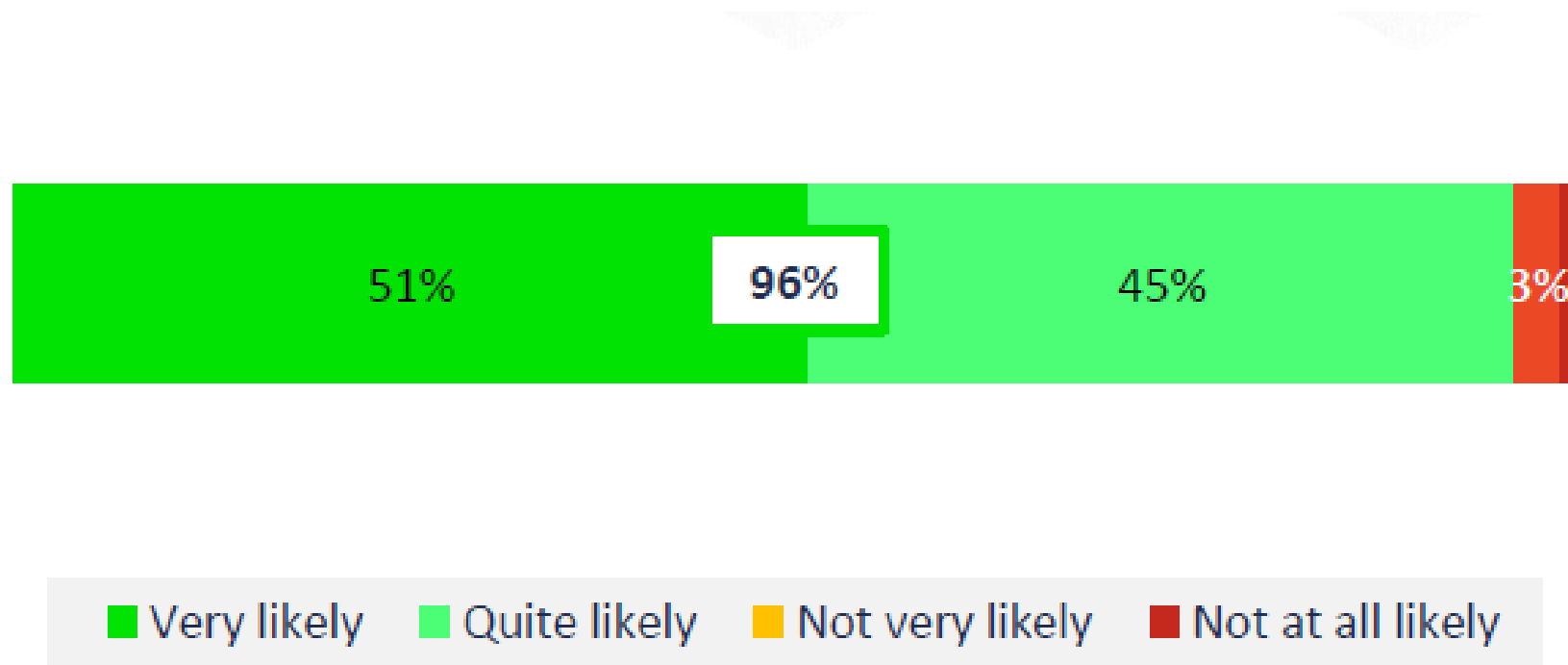


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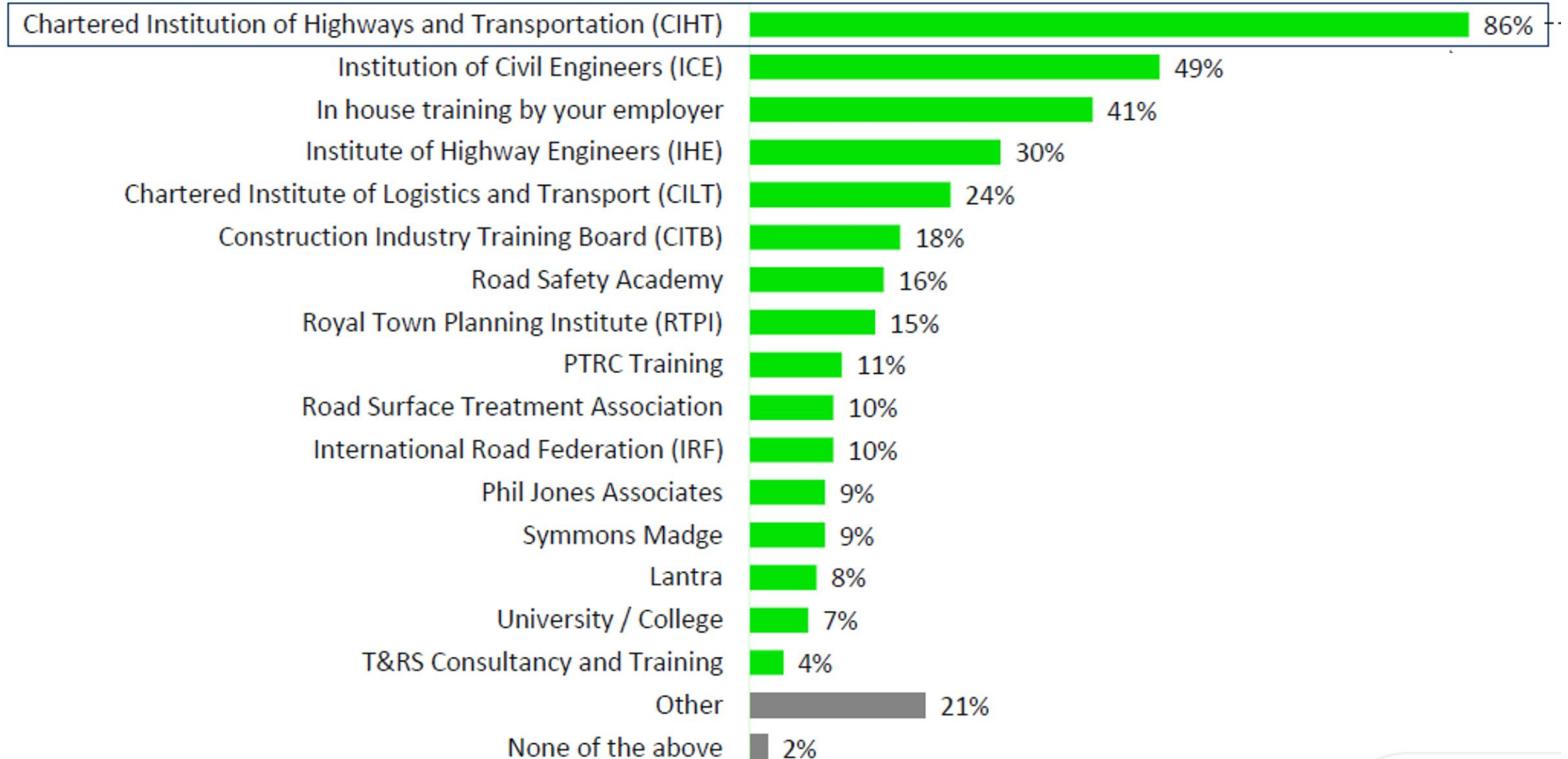

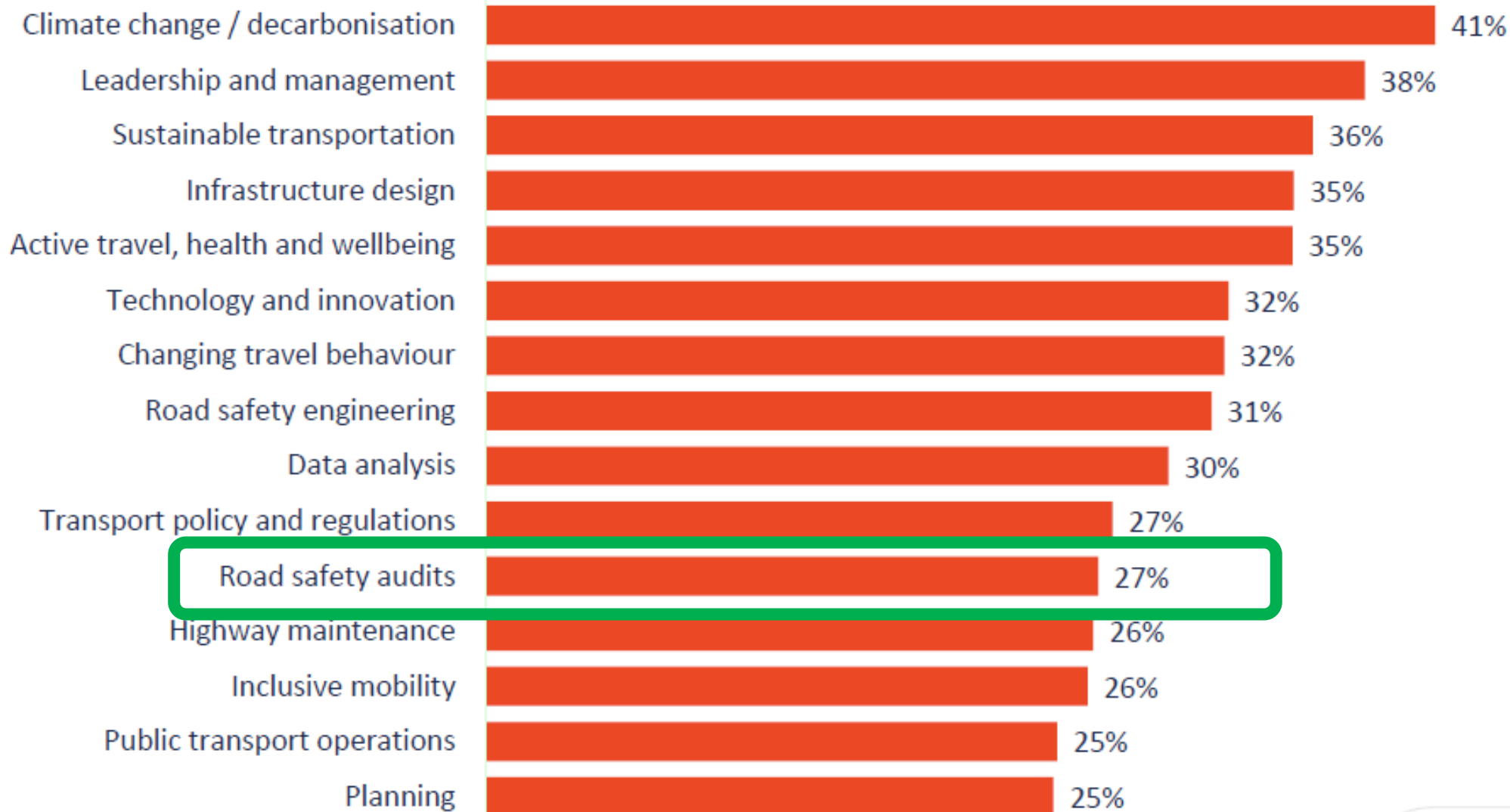
How likely would you be to recommend CIHT Learn to a colleague if it was relevant to them?

10-Module Personal Injury Collision Investigation and Road Safety Engineering

- This course is a new approved digital equivalent to the 'Ten Day' formal training requirement in road safety engineering and collision investigation, and satisfies a core requirement for those seeking to become qualified Road Safety Auditors -
- The course is divided into 10 modules (skill development) and then independent learning (completing an assignment). Delegates must complete all 10 modules and the assignment to obtain the 10-Module CPD certificate.



10-Module Personal Injury Collision Investigation and Road Safety Engineering

- Content includes:
 - UK and Global road safety policy
 - Road traffic injury collision causation factors
 - Interpret accident data and triangulate the findings to optimise collision reduction strategies
 - Road traffic collision mitigation measures and the economic impact of road traffic collisions.
 - An international perspective on the causation factors of personal injury in the UK
 - Regional and local perspectives on personal injury caused by road traffic collisions.

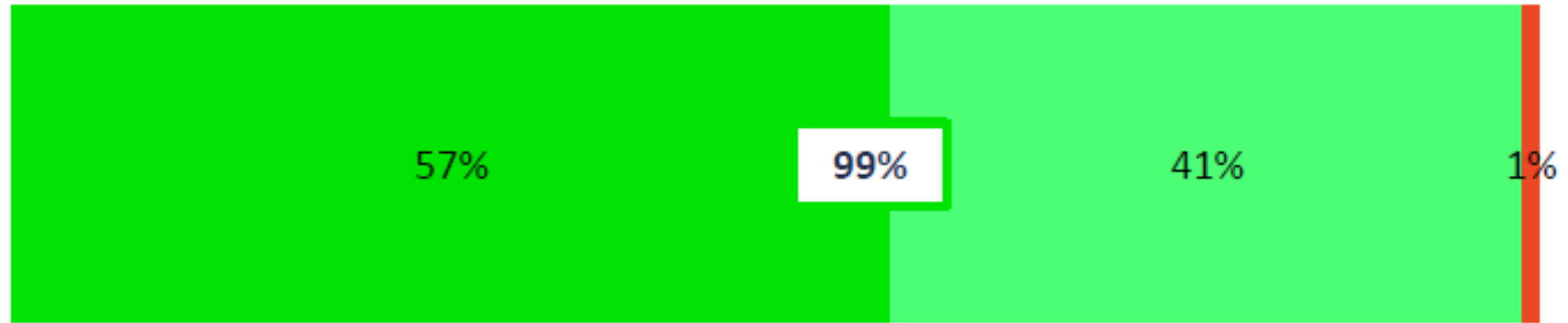

Opportunities
