


# How likely would you be to recommend CIHT Learn to a colleague if it was relevant to them?

## **ROSPA** 10-Module Personal Injury Collision Investigation and Road Safety Engineering

- This course is a new approved digital equivalent to the 'Ten Day' formal training requirement in road safety engineering and collision investigation, and satisfies a core requirement for those seeking to become qualifies Road Safety Auditors -





# Opportunities
