

3,118 reports of road incidents involving horses

58 Horses killed

97 Horses injured

80 Riders injured

81% of these incidents were because vehicles passed too close or too fast to the horse.



VULNERABLE ROAD USERS



> Oxford dictionary definition of vulnerable:

"Exposed to the possibility of being attacked or harmed, either physically or emotionally." Highway Code 2022

- > Road users most at risk from road traffic are in particular horse riders.
- Road users most likely to be injured in the event of a collision are....horse riders.

➤ Does that mean we are simply more vulnerable because what other road users might or might not do?



- > Influencing driver behaviour if they see a horse on the road.






10 DEAD SLOW HORSES ARE UNPREDICTABLE

2 METRES

PASSING HORSES WIDE AND SLOW CAN PREVENT THE DEATH OF DRIVERS, RIDERS AND HORSES.



If I see a horse on the road, then I will...





Slow Down to a maximum 10mph

Be patient, I won't sound my horn or rev my engine

(When safe to do so) Pass the horse wide and slow (at least a cars width, 2m, if possible)

Drive slowly away






Even the best trained horse can react to something on its nearside.



Most responsibility








HIGHWAY CODE 2022

 horse riders, whose horse is likely to be trightened if you pass noisily, suddenly or too fast.

Pass horse riders and horse-drawn vehicles at speeds under 10 mph and allow at least 2 metres of space. Feral or semi feral ponies found in areas such as the New Forest, Exmoor and Dartmoor require the same consideration as ridden horses when approaching or passing.




