Origins Award 2026

The Origins Award recognises the importance of celebrating the outstanding work delivered by professionals based in Wales on projects beyond its borders. It highlights the contribution Welsh expertise makes to the wider highways and transport sector, showcasing innovation, leadership and technical excellence achieved on a national and international stage. The award aims to acknowledge individuals, teams and companies who, while working outside Wales, continue to demonstrate the high standards, values and professionalism associated with the Welsh industry, reinforcing the reach and impact of talent from across Wales.

Entrants will explain how as a Welsh individual, team or company, they delivered highways and transport related work outside of Wales. Submissions should focus on the unique contribution they or their team brought to the project, highlighting how they improved social, environmental, economic, innovation, design and delivery project outcomes.

Entries can be single projects and schemes or wider programmes of work and strategies delivered by Welsh individuals, teams or companies, outside of Wales.
